PARISH REGISTRATION

“While there are many kinds and degrees of participation in a parish, a common thread is a deliberate decision to belong. This implies, for example, that people register in the parish, attend its services, provide for its financial support, and take part in its various activities. In other words, belonging to a parish requires an active commitment, not merely a passive response.”
Joseph Cardinal Bernardin

Though a rather simple act, registration is a sign of one’s commitment and responsibility to the parish. In practical terms, registration allows the parish to know how many families live in the parish. It also provides an official record of your membership and is essential for participation in parish programs and sacraments.

We encourage everyone to formally register as members of Saint Patrick Catholic Church by stopping by the church office during business hours (Monday – Friday, 8:00 – 4:00) or by completing a registration card which can be found in the pews or at the Welcome table at the main entrance of the church after each Mass.

SACRAMENTS

Infant Baptism and Marriage: Because of the important community nature of the celebrations of Baptism and Marriage in the church, interested parties are expected to make advanced arrangements to allow time for appropriate preparation programs to be completed; for Baptism, preferably before the birth of the child or at least three months notice is required and for Marriage, at least six months notice is required.

For baptisms contact, Johnnie Winters at the church office at 323-2410 ext. 107 for requirements, preferably before the child’s arrival. For marriage contact, Beth O’Leary, Family Life Ministry, at least six months before the desired date.

First Penance and First Communion: Contact Chris Potter-Wroblewski in the church office at 323-2410 ext. 110 for requirements.

Reconciliation: The Sacrament of Penance (confession) is celebrated each Saturday from 3:30 – 5:00 in the church. In addition, the sacrament is available by appointment. Please call the church office to set up an appointment.

Hospital Visits/Anointing of the Sick: Please notify the Church office if you or a member of your family are hospitalized, or if the Sacrament of the Sick is needed. Due to HIPAA laws visitation by clergy/lay ministers may be denied unless you inform us .

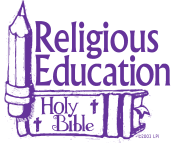

Do you know of a parishioner that is in the hospital or homebound?

Due to HIPAA laws we often do not know when someone is in the hospital or that they are in a nursing home or assisted living facility unless the parishioner or a family member contacts us. We have a well organized system for those that are homebound, in a nursing home or hospital, to receive Holy Communion from Lay Ministers, but it is important that you let us know where you are or that you would like us to visit you. Even if it is only temporary due to chemotherapy treatments, rehabilitation, or if the need is long term, just contact Beth O'Leary, to set up weekly visits from a Minister of Holy Communion.

Within a 15 week period these short announcements will be placed in the bulletin as helpful excerpts from the U.S. Bishops pastoral letter entitled *Follow the Way of Love*. You can find the document at <http://www.usccb.org/laity/follow.shtml>. This document helps promote family life with a Catholic understanding.

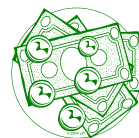

Tips For Healthy Living from your Parish Health Cabinet

October is breast cancer awareness month. Despite some current controversy over the recommendations for breast cancer detection, the American Cancer Society still recommends Self Breast Exams, yearly Clinical Breast Exams (both to begin at age 20), and yearly Mammograms for women over 40. The American Cancer Society also advocates prompt reporting of breast symptoms.

Pine Straw Needed

Pine straw is needed to mulch the crepe myrtles and flower beds throughout the Church property. 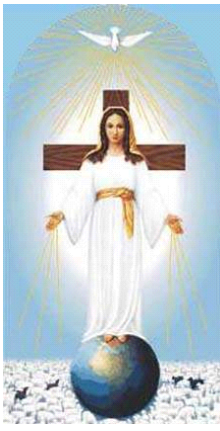
